



Senior Domestic Competition Extreme Heat Policy

The following modifications will be implemented to Knox Basketball's Senior Domestic Competition if the court area temperature is 35°C or higher.

- Compulsory time-outs (of one minute duration) will be called by the match referee's at approximately;
 - The 12 and 6 minute marks of each half.
 - The 5 minute mark of each quarter for Men 1 Competitions.These time-outs are in addition to the regular 2 time-outs per team allocated each half.
- The court area temperature will be recorded at 2 stages throughout the course of the game. The first reading will take place by the Referee Supervisor prior to the start of the game, and the second reading will take place at half time of the game.
- Matches must be abandoned when the court area temperature reaches 40°C.

Abandoned Matches

In the event that the court area temperature exceeds the above stated temperature and games must be abandoned, the following will take place:

- If the game is abandoned prior to the start of the game, a draw will be declared with 2 premiership points awarded to both teams and Game Fee refunded.
- If the game is abandoned at half time of the game, the current scores will stand as the final result for that game and no refund will be given for the Game Fee.
